Plan Ahead

- 1. Start planning your project in winter to break ground in spring/summer.
- 2. Plan for larger projects in phases and anticipate two weeks for each phase of work.
- 3. Check that you have the space to accommodate your project(s).
- 4. Find out what building permits are needed.
- 5. Review bids and consider the quote that comes in the middle, never go with the lowest bid to save money.
- 6. Check out the license and insurance of the company you want to work with.

During The Build

- 1. Make sure you have the money to pay in full when the build starts and anticipate that the cost can go up as the project moves along.
- 2. Put it on your schedule to be home during construction.
- 3. Review the work daily to maintain good communication with your builder and to ensure there are no mistakes that would cost you more money and delay the project.
